A CALL INTO SPECIAL SERVICE

- (a) Deliver him in time of trouble;**
- (b) Preserve him and keep him alive;**
- (c) He shall be blessed upon the earth;**
- (d) God will not deliver him to the will of his enemies;**
- (e) He will heal them and restore their strength when they are ill.**

Wow! The reward is great!!

(iii) You cannot lose while helping the poor because:

“Giving to the poor is investing in God’s business”, and no one loses in any business with God.

(iv) It will bring fulfillment to your life as:

“Fulfillment in life comes from meeting the needs in other people’s lives, especially the poor –the less fortunate ones.

(v) It has eternal benefits because looking after the interest of the poor pays eternal dividends; and

(vi) You shall never lack: **“Proverb; 28:27 – He that giveth unto the poor SHALL NOT LACK, but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse;**

A Challenging Example

After Zaccheaus gave his heart and life to the Lord, among the restitutions he made was that:- He gave half of his possessions to the Lord. (Luke 19:8).

A Negative Example

The rich man in Luke 16:19 – preferred to use his belongings only for himself, family and his dog. He was not moved to help “poor Lazarus” who could neither feed nor take care of himself. This rich man didn’t send anything to heaven ahead of him, (through giving to the poor around him). In the end, he himself became a beggar in heaven. That will not be your portion in Jesus name.

Being rich does not mean you have all the conveniences of life – but you are better off than those who do not find it easy to afford their daily meal, nor can easily maintain their children’s school fees, etc.

Some ways in which we intend to help them

The following are some ways through which we intend to help the poor:-

1. Giving them training in Small Scale Enterprises that they can embark upon, after which they will be given a revolving loan to set up, either as a group or as individuals;
2. Giving them assistance in the area of urgent needs; training and teaching them to do something on their own. They will also be assisted with Loan Capital or take-off grant for their micro-enterprises;
3. Helping children of those in critical needs to go to school by financing their education either wholly or in part until they can do it on their own through the enterprise they got trained for;
4. In most cases, these category of people are excluded during celebrations – so we intend to bring them joy through organizing fellowship parties for them during festivities;
5. Through giving gifts in cash or materials during special festivals;

6. Occasional distribution of raw food items and/or cash; and any other thing God will lead us to do in the future.

In other to make this project a reality, God laid it on our heart to share this burden with the people of God who will want to have a part in this vision; thereby offering special service unto God. Remember, Jesus said that when you meet the needs of the less privileged, you are doing it for him; Matthew 25: 34-40; so it is a special service unto God.

Also, as you give, you are lending to God and He will pay you in good returns – Proverbs 19:17. Hence, the project is tagged: Project “Lending unto God”. In this regard, we encourage you to partner with us in this Godly project and the Lord will do you good.
